

HBOT Treatment Process for Veterans

- Contact Healing Arizona Veterans (HAV) by email at: healingarizonaveterans@gmail.com or by phone: (520) 544-5699. If you contact HAV by phone, please leave a voicemail with your name, contact information and request. An HAV Representative will call you back to discuss your case.
- If your contact deems it appropriate for you to proceed to the next step, you will be referred to HAV's Medical Director, Dr. Carol Henricks for assessment.
- Dr. Henricks will discuss your case with you by phone and, if appropriate in person by appointment, at NorthStar Hyperbaric in Tucson.
- If Dr. Henricks decides it is appropriate to proceed to the next steps, she will order diagnostic tests (these may include MRI-DTI, sleep pattern analysis, toxicity analysis).
- Once the test results are obtained, Dr. Henricks will decide if HBOT is appropriate in your case.
- If you have been cleared for treatment, HAV will determine if they have the funding to do so. If HAV does not have the funding, they will work with you to contact other organizations that may provide the funding.
- Once the funding has been secured, you will be sent to either NorthStar Hyperbarics in Tucson or Hyperbaric Therapy of Arizona in Phoenix for treatment. The location will be determined based on convenience for you.
- At the completion of the treatment, you will be asked to undergo the same diagnostic tests as at the beginning of the treatment. This will determine the clinical efficacy of your treatment.
- The staff of HAV will work with you to provide data on the costs of treating your condition one year prior to your HBOT treatment. This data can be obtained from the Veterans Administration and will enable HAV to assess the financial efficacy of your HBOT treatment.
- If you are happy with the treatment, you will be asked – at your discretion – to make a statement, audio or video testimonial to encourage other veterans like you to undergo the treatment.
