



## Donating to Healing Arizona Veterans A 501 (c)(3) and State of Arizona QCO

### Policy

As a 501(c)(3) organization and a Qualified Charitable Organization (QCO), contributions to Healing Arizona Veterans (HAV) are tax-deductible against Federal taxable income if you itemize deductions.

HAV is also an Arizona Qualified Charitable Organization (QCO code 22353). Contributions made to QCOs allow taxpayers to claim a **dollar-for-dollar tax credit** against their Arizona income tax liability.

### Amounts

For the 2023 tax year, the maximum allowable credit is \$841.00 for taxpayers filing jointly and \$421.00 for all other filers.

For the 2024 tax year, the maximum allowable credit is \$938.00 for taxpayers filing jointly and \$470.00 for all other filers.

### Process

To receive an Arizona QCO income tax credit for your donation to Healing Arizona Veterans

- Make your donation to Healing Arizona Veterans on our website through Anedot or mail a check to Healing Arizona Veterans, P.O. Box 64242, Tucson, AZ 85728
- Anedot will email you an electronic receipt if you pay online. If you donate by check, Healing Arizona Veterans will mail you an acknowledgement receipt. Keep a copy of this receipt for your tax records.
- You, or your accountant, will need to complete Arizona Form 321, Credit for Qualifying Charitable Organizations (QCO). Healing Arizona Veterans Qualifying Charity Code is 22353.
- Submit the Arizona Form 321 with your Arizona Personal Income Tax Return.
